The Apprenticeship Training Scheme is for one year period and is primarily on-job training provided by the industry/establishments utilizing their own infrastructures aiming to bridge the Skill-Gap, the students possess and what is required for gainful employment. More than 30,000 students passing out from different institutes in Eastern Region are being benefitted every year through this flagship National Apprenticeship Training Scheme (NATS) of Govt. of India.
